In Fall 2012, Dr. Kataoka presented our collaborative research paper, entitled, "International Comparative Study on the Structure of Attitudes Toward Gender Role Norms" at the International Congress of Family and Consumer Science in Antalya, Turkey. In Summer 2013, Drs. Kataoka and Fukino received funding from the Japanese government for a multi-year study (2013-2016), comparing attitudes about gender norms in the U.S., Turkey, and Japan, which funded travel to Japan in Summer 2014. By Spring 2016, we had collected data at each site and are currently analyzing the data.
